Kyiv Christian Academy is a private international K-12 school founded in 1993 for the purpose of educating missionary children in Ukraine.

COMMUNITY

KCA is located in Kyiv, the capital city of Ukraine, which has a population of approximately 3 million.

CURRICULUM

KCA uses a rigorous English language college preparatory curriculum from North America, with honors courses in English and Russian and AP Calculus. KCA also facilitates online classes through North Star Academy to enable students to supplement course loads and earn additional AP credits.

KCA is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA).

This early language exposure often enables KCA graduates to test out of their university language requirements, or to be placed in advanced levels. Many high school students also acquire a level of language proficiency that allows them to work as translators. In addition to Russian, Ukrainian is offered in middle and high school as an elective.
