CURRICULUM

KCA uses a rigorous English language college preparatory curriculum from North America, with honors courses in English, Russian and Pre-Calculus. AP Calculus and AP Physics are also offered. KCA facilitates online classes through North Star Academy to enable students the opportunity to supplement course loads with an even more challenging level of education and earn additional AP credits. In addition, we accept the earning of dual credits through approved colleges.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

KCA students begin studying Russian in Kindergarten and most continue through twelfth grade. This early language exposure often enables KCA graduates to test out of their university language requirements, or to be placed in advanced levels. Many high school students also acquire a level of language proficiency that allows them to work as translators. In addition to Russian, Ukrainian is offered in high school as an elective.
