KCA moved to a brand new campus in 2019. The safety of students and staff is a priority. The campus is well designed with security enclosures surrounding the facility. The property is well lit, locked and a full-time guard is on the premises at all times. There is one main building consisting of elementary, middle and high school wings, playgrounds and sports field.

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE

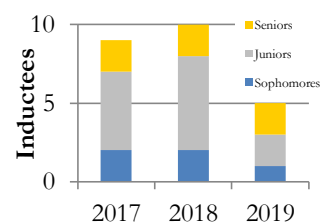

This early language exposure often enables KCA graduates to test out of their university language requirements, or to be placed in advanced levels. Many high school students also acquire a level of language proficiency that allows them to work as interpreters.

## COVID-19 RESPONSE

In **Spring 2020**, Ukraine closed all educational institutions on March 12, 2020, to prevent the spread of COVID-19. KCA responded with immediate transfer to online education for all core classes. Students who had passed elective classes in quarter 3, were given a pass for quarter 4. No final exams were given. There were no changes to the grading scale. Semester grades are factored into the overall GPA, per usual grading policy.

In **Fall 2020**, KCA began school on campus for all students. Students who must remain at home are able to continue to learn through the support of teachers using online learning platforms.
